Szawłowski Potato Farms, Inc. was started by a Polish immigrant, John R. Szawłowski, in 1910. The farm has weathered changing economies, new lifestyles and even the seizure of the original farm for an industrial park. Now the largest potato grower in Massachusetts, it is headed by four grandsons of John. The corporation now grows potatoes on 2,500 acres of land in Hatfield, Northampton and Whately. Since deciding to branch out in 1989, the farm has been packaging potatoes for other growers. Packaging potatoes from other growers year-round now brings in about fifty percent of the farm's income. The farm has sustained itself through the years on the foundation of deep devotion to farming, quality of goods and reliability.
