Burnham Farm was established in the late 1800's by Robert E. Burnham. Today the farm is run by the fourth generation of the Burnham family David, Kevin and Jamie. Their great-grand Grandfather started farming 500 acres of Corn, Pumpkins, Green Peppers and Tomatoes in East Hartford, CT. In keeping with their family tradition, the Burnham family continues to harvest 350 acres of these same crops. In addition, this year, the Burnham family successfully added green beans to their harvest. Burnham Farm is one of New England's top corn growers; there is a number of retailers and wholesalers that travel to East Hartford daily to purchase and pick their crop. Burnham also maintains over twenty greenhouses for harvesting spring plants. The Sardilli family has been working with Burnham Farm for over 25 years.
